Seminar description

In the context of multiple overlapping crises, higher education has a huge responsibility for the transformation of education and society as we look to 2050 and beyond. This Seminar will begin by exploring the main messages of the 2021 report from the International Commission on the Futures of Education: [Reimagining Our Futures Together: A new social contract for education](#).

Professor António Nóvoa, who led the drafting committee, will present the report's main messages and reflect on their implications for higher education. Specific topics, such as international cooperation, global citizenship and environmental sustainability will then be taken up by invited UNESCO Chairholders. As education institutions, universities must be fully committed to basic education. They must also be organized for inter-disciplinary research and contribute to the knowledge commons. Beyond 'learning', higher education involves presence, participation, conviviality, equity, and pluralism with social justice. Yet, the distinctive features of higher education institutions are at risk from marketization and commercialization.

The International Commission proposes 'a new social contract' as a living vision of change shaped by three foundational principles. First, quality education throughout life as a human right. Second, education as a collective public endeavour and a common good. Third, education must reflect humanity's wide diversity of ways of knowing, living, and being to address interconnected challenges through the acquisition, application, and generation of knowledge.

This Seminar will engage UNESCO Chairs and UNITWIN Networks, and other experts, on the implications of the International Commission's report for the futures of higher education.
