#### Seminar description

One of the main outputs of the 3rd World Higher Education Conference ([WHEC2022](#)), organized by UNESCO in Barcelona, 18-20 May 2022, was a **Higher Education Roadmap** entitled [Beyond Limits: New Ways to Reinvent Higher Education](#).

The Roadmap outlines a vision to rethink, reimagine, and reinvent Higher Education in light of the challenges and opportunities associated with global threats faced by humanity and the planet. It addresses the evolving landscape of higher education institutions, outlines six principles to shape the futures of higher education, identifies major challenges in reinventing higher education, and proposes practical approaches to translate dialogue into action and results.

Resulting from a process of research, dialogue and consultation with UNESCO Member States and Higher Education stakeholders globally, this Roadmap was presented during the WHEC2022 as a working version to encourage further thinking and debate among all higher education stakeholders at global, regional, and country levels.

UNESCO is looking to further enrich the document in the follow-up to the WHEC2022, based on the conversations that took place during the conference and with the abundant material presented in the WHEC2022 digital library. **There is now an open call for contributions, which aims to collect relevant feedback, novel perspectives/information and outstanding examples from UNESCO Member States, Higher Education related organizations, and individuals/experts, to enrich the Roadmap.** Information about this process and how to contribute is available on the [WHEC2022 website](#). The deadline for contributions is 15 February 2023.

This Seminar aims to introduce the Roadmap and to discuss key topics analysed, focusing on the main challenges experienced by the Higher Education sector globally and possible pathways to address them.
